The programming will be a series of after-school events at the library, as soon as it is deemed safe for public gatherings. The programs will be a continuation of programs already begun prior to the advent of the Coronavirus and will begin with a series of Lego challenges and move on to more complex lessons, including electrical circuits, motors, robotics, forensics, computer coding and soil science.
