The Beaman Community Memorial Library is the recipient of a grant from the Grundy County Community Foundation. The grant will fund a story walk in the library's Discovery Garden. A story walk places a children's book page by page along a walking path, to be read as the walk progresses. It's a fun way to enjoy reading and the outdoors at the same time, and the stories can be changed periodically. The **StoryWalk®** Project was created by Anne Ferguson of Montpelier, VT and developed in collaboration with the Vermont Bicycle & Pedestrian Coalition and the Kellogg Hubbard Library. They can be found all over the country. The library will install the story walk in May prior to Beaman's Memorial Day celebration.
