Dear Friends Board Members,

I recently had a walk through with a new architect from FEH out of Sioux City, and she and her team have provided us with an updated quote for their services.

Not surprisingly, this is higher than it was in 2018 for a variety of reasons.

We were given \$37,000 towards this project by an anonymous donor, and the architects fees throughout the project will come to \$26,900. I shared that we need to get to a point of having a plan that will allow us to collect bids so that we know what further funds we need to seek. She mentioned that they could put this on their calendar after the first of the year, go through the schematic development and then pause to allow for our fundraising efforts before continuing further.

That is, if you choose to move forward.

Please feel free to discuss, ask questions, and vote about whether to move forward with the proposal if/when you're ready. (We'll need a motion and a second, when you decide you're at that point.)

FEH has done a number of beautiful library projects throughout the state and has an excellent reputation.

- Cheryl: I would make a motion to accept the proposal from FEH Design for architectural, structural, mechanical and engineering services for the Community Room at the Estherville Public Library.
