The Fertile Public Library is pleased to offer two Kindle e-Book readers for loan and a Kindle Fire (for in-library use) to library patrons. Our goal in starting this service is to offer you an e-reader so you can make informed decisions should you decide to purchase one. You can decide whether this new technology delivers reading in a way that fits your lifestyle. Or you can use it to check out books on BRIDGES that are not available in the library collection. To check out an e-Reader you must be 18 years of age and have a signed Kindle Borrowing Agreement on file assuming financial responsibility for lost or damaged equipment.

You must be 8 years of age to use the Kindle Fire and have a signed consent form from a parent or guardian assuming financial responsibility for lost or damaged equipment. Patrons 18 years or older must have a signed Kindle Borrowing Agreement on file.

The library is not responsible for any liability or damages or expense resulting from the use or misuse of the device, connection of the device to other electronic devices, or data loss resulting from use of the device.
