### **Refrigerator Pickles**

3 cups cucumbers, peeled and sliced 1 onion, thinly sliced 3/4 cup sugar 2/3 cup white vinegar 1/2 tsp. celery seed 1/4 tsp. salt 1/2 tsp. mustard seed Mix cucumbers and onion in a glass or plastic bowl. Pour rest of ingredients over cucumber mixture. Cover and refrigerate for 24 hours before serving to blend flavors. Keep refrigerated. Makes one quart. **ZUCCHINI BREAD** Bake at 325 degrees 1 hour

3 eggs 1 cup white sugar, 1 cup brown sugar (Or you may use 2 cups of white sugar) 1 cup oil 2 cups grated zucchini 1 tsp. vanilla 3 cups flour ½ tsp. cinnamon 1 tsp. baking powder 1 tsp. baking soda 1 tsp salt 1 cup nuts (optional) raisins also optional Beat eggs till frothy. Add oil, sugars. vanilla and zucchini. Mix well with beater. Sift dry ingredients, add to egg mixture.
