City Council Meeting Minutes

September 16, 2014 - 7:00 PM, City Hall

Call to Order & Roll Call

Present were: Mayor Joyce Russell; Council Members: Jeff Berg, Julie Jessen, Nick Bailey and Holly Lovik-Hanna; City Clerk, Wendy Lunning & Maintenance Manager Steve Roberts. Absent: Tad Miller
Holly motioned, Nick 2nd to approve the minutes of August 19th meeting. Unanimous

- **Julie motioned, Holly 2nd to accept agenda. Unanimous.**

Agendas are posted at City Hall, at the Library, and at the Post Office, 24 hours in advance of each Council Meeting. If you wish to be on the Agenda, please contact City Hall two days before the meeting.

Danko Emergency Equipment Co. Siren

- Butch Hoffman was available to display proposed siren for the City of Fertile. The proposed siren is compliant with the Fire Department and Winnebago and Worth County Sherriff Departments. Butch suggested that a 6:00 siren and timer be included also.

City Maintenance Report

- Steve worked with Scott Shover from IA Rural Water to calibrate the sewer pumps for efficiency. He also worked with Joe Finch from IA Rural Water to check some Mains for water leakage.
- Steve and Warren have completed paperwork for the DNR in regards to excess usage and missing water sample violation.
- Steve has contacted Larson Plumbing in regards to meters that need to be replaced.
- Steve is working on sidewalk on W Main Street beside Maintenance Garage.
- **Nick motioned, Holly 2nd to approve the maintenance report. Unanimous.**

Mayor's Report

- Joyce notified Chris Hanna in regards to equipment that was available from the Federal Government at no cost. This is equipment that was previously used in the military.
- Joyce has sent all building permits to the Worth County Court house for 2013.

- New snow ordinance signs are needed for each of the four entries into town. Quotes were presented to the council for 18 X 24 black lettering on white sign. **Julie motioned, Jeff 2nd to accept the quote. Unanimous.**
- Joyce received new copies of the ordinances books from NIACOG that have recently been codified. Copies are available at the Worth County Attorney's office, Worth County Sherriff's office, Fertile City Hall, Fertile Library and online at city website: www.fertileiowa.us. Each council member, city clerk, and mayor also has a copy. The 2002 copies of the Ordinances will need to be returned to Joyce.
- The transmission is not working properly on the city pickup. Steve will be taking to Franks Repair to get estimates on the cost of repair for the council.
- Plunketts will be spraying for bugs at the Community Center, City Hall and Maintenance Garage at the end of September.
- **Holly motioned, and Nick 2nd to approve the mayor's report. Unanimous.**

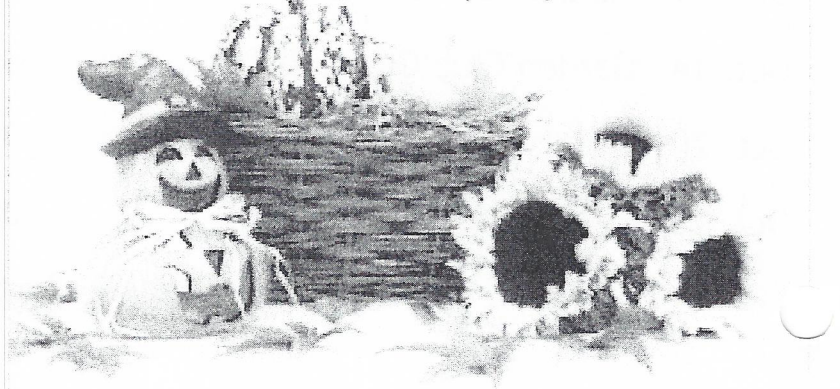

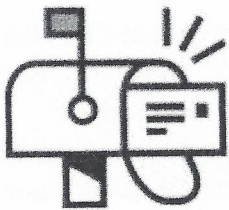

COOK'S CORNER

PIZZA SPAGHETTI

¾ lb. Thin spaghetti, cooked and drained
2 eggs, beaten
¾ c. milk
1 (32 oz.) jar spaghetti sauce
1 lb. uncooked hamburger
Sliced pepperoni
2 c. Shredded Mozzarella cheese
1 c. shredded Cheddar cheese
Mix eggs and milk; toss with spaghetti. Spread in Pam-sprayed 9x18 inch pan, or two smaller ones. Top with spaghetti sauce. Sprinkle uncooked hamburger in pinch –size pieces over top of sauce. Press down into sauce a little. Arrange sliced pepperoni in rows over this. Top with cheeses. Bake at 350 degrees for 30 minutes or until bubbly and hamburger is done. Let stand 5 minutes. Cut in squares.

NOTE: May be frozen for baking at a later time

EASY CINNAMON ROLLS

2 loaves frozen bread
1 lg. pkg. vanilla pudding (not instant)
½ cup butter or oleo
½ tsp . Cinnamon
1 c. brown sugar
2 T. milk
Let dough thaw, but not rise. Break 1 loaf in a greased 9 x 13 inch pan. Don't be fussy. Combine other ingredients until melted on stove; pour over dough. Break other loaf and put it over all. Let rise. **Bake at 350 – 375 degrees for ½ hour.**

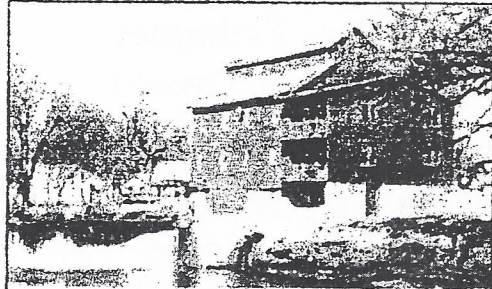

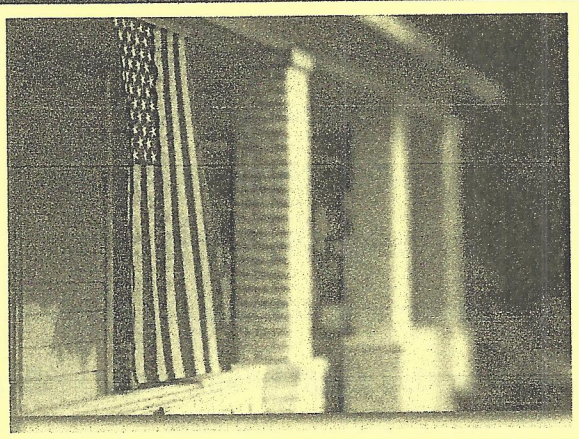

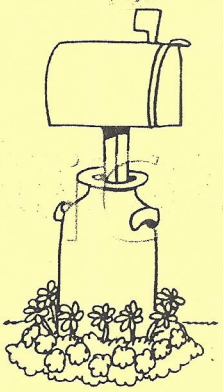
