ATTENTION

We want to be sure that everyone in Fertile who plans to hook up to the municipal water system - understands that they must send their \$20.00 deposit to the city clerk or any member of the town council immediately. FHA requires that we have the total hook-up cost of \$80.00 from each household planning to be on city water, by October 15th.

We also want to be sure that it is understood that anyone who doesn't hook up now, and decides to do so later, will be paying the actual costs which are estimated to be a minimum of \$250 - \$300. By doing it now, both water and sewer pipe can be in the same ditch dug from the edge of your lot line to your house, which will result in considerable savings.
