February minutes were read and approved.

Motion to pay appraisal fees on Lagoon site from Sewer Construction Fund. Carried.

Motion to pay for Maintainer purchased from Interstate Equipment Co. by Check Warrant from Citizens Savings Bank until Road Use C.D's mature. Carried.

Motion to place Sewer Fund C.D. in Passbook Savings until FMHA interest is due. Carried.

We received \$11,700 extra Grant money from FMHA for our Sewer Project.

Discussion on Lagoon. Bob Ouverson and Jack Delbridge were present. Ouverson stated "S and O" will continue to pick up incurred Engineering Fees, Int. and other expenses due to delay of Lagoon not yet finished." The Council will continue to wave the penalty clause as long as reasonable effort is made to complete the job.
