Voting on November 6th in Fertile went as follows: 87 ballots were cast. Write in votes for Mayor were 22 for Richard Worsley, 16 Dennis Faber, 9 Larry Shropshire. Council votes 81 for Fred Hare, 78 Jean VanDenBosch, 78 Worsley, 77 Faber, 76 Kenneth Lundgren and 27 Tom Hewett.

COUNCIL MEETING

The regular council meeting was held October 29, 1979 at the library with Mayor Shropshire presiding. Council members present were VanDenBosch, Waage, Faber and Worsley.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

David Low was present and was willing to do the sewage treatment work for the city. Motion was made he be hired to begin in November at \$300 per month. Carried.

Pre-construction meeting for the water project will be November 8 at 1:30 at the library.

Discussion on raising the wages for Mayor and Council. Motion was made that the Mayor receive \$500 per year and Council members receive \$10 per meeting. Carried.
