COUNCIL MEETING

The Fertile Town Council met June 2, with Mayor Worsley presiding and council members Hare, Faber, Burtness and Vanden Bosch present. Others present were Harriet Ouverson, Viola Roberts, Leo Oswald, Jerry Ouverson, Arden Midtgaard, Ron Almelien, Gary Calgaard, Charles Waage, Ed Buchanan, LaVern Lee, Lester Burtness, David Bruns, Morris Norem, and Larry Shropshire.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

A committe working on acquiring the Fertile school building for use by the community was present. Arden Midtgaard spokesman gave costs of various ideas on renovation. Leo Oswald reported on possible ways of financing the operation of the building. Dennis Faber will represent the town council on this committee. The entire group will meet with the Forest City School Board on Monday, June 8.

Discussion on drain tile and drainage by the sewer lagoon. The town will do some work on the ditch there.

The Fire Department was given approval to buy some new boots and fire hose.

Council discussed cleaning and checking the water tower.

Discussion on manhole covers, street construction and ditch repair. Council will work on the ditch on Washington Street and put in culvert by Les Lindquist property.

Motion to pay monthly bills. Carried. Discussion on lighting horseshoe court in the park.

Discussion on maintenance man. Motion to buy a weed-eater for use in the park. Carried. Motion to pay \$5/hour for part time maintenance labor, with a minimal raise in 90 days. Carried.

Mayor Worsley proclaimed June as Clean-up, Paint-up, Fix-up Month in Fertile to encourage everyone to be ready for the 125th celebration August 1 and 2. Motion was made to adopt a resolution to amend the budget as published.Carried. Meeting adjourned.
