Motion to appoint Larry Shropshire to fill the remaining term of Ray Sandifer. Carried. Oath of office was administered by Mayor Smith.

Minutes of previous meeting were read and approved.

Council discussed stump removal in the park. Price was received of \$15 per stump. Mayor will contact stump removal company.

Letter from Worth Co. Conservation to city and 2 letters from City Attorney to Worth Co. Conservation were read. Felland reported a meeting will be held with Conservation Commission on Thurs., May 5th.

Library Board members and the Librarian were present to discuss Library sign. Also roof repair. They will get estimates. They will work on fund raising ideas.

With a few minor fix up clean up things, we think we are ready to "PLAY BALL"!!

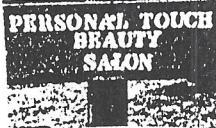

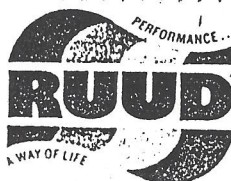

Word was received this past week of the death of Pastor Arnold Hedin of Forest City, Ia. Pastor Hedin served the Fertile Lutheran and Pilot Knob churches from 1964 to 1978. He touched the lifes of many people in the Fertile area. Our deepest sympathy is extended to his wife Alice and children Paul, John, Joyce and Mary Ann and to their families. He will be missed by many.

Arnold Merlin Hedin was born on May 27, 1925, in Willmar, Mn, son of Emil and Esther (Hanson) Hedin. He grew up in Lake Lillian, Mn. He attended school there and on May 27, 1950 was married to Alice Knudson at Our Saviors Lutheran Church in Inwood, Ia. He is an alumnus of the Lutheran Bible Institute of Minneapolis, Mn, a graduate of Augustana College, Sioux Falls, SD and Luther Theological Seminary in St. Paul, Mn.

Arnold was a "builder" in many different ways. His ingenuity and creativity rendered blueprints obsolete as steel and wood came together with amazing precision. He loved to repair and rebuild cars and engines and did so with a knack few could match. But most important he was called to build for the Kingdom of God. As a Pastor he spent 25 years in the parish ministry, having served congregations in Underwood, Mn, Fertile, Ia, and Franklin, Mn. He served as Director of Public Relations for the Latin American Mission for 7½ years. Most recently he and his wife Alice produced the radio program "The Hour of Hope". He also served as Colleague Evangelist for Lutherans for Evangelism and as support staff at Lee Valley Ranch in South Dakota.

He Died on May 4, 1993, at the age of 67 years. He is survived by his wife, Alice of Forest City, his children and their spouses & children: Paul Hedin and his wife Beth and their children, David & Diana of Evergreen, Co; John Hedin and his wife Lisa of Pittsburgh Pa; Joyce Schmidt and her husband Tim and their children, Elizabeth, Marie and Nathaniel of Forest City; Mary Ann Sherman and her husband Steve and their children Aaron and Andrea of Sioux Falls, SD; a brother Donald and his wife Margaret of Lake Lillian, Mn. He was preceded in death by his parents.

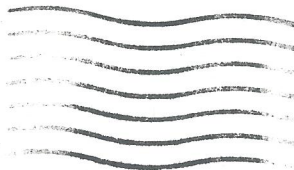
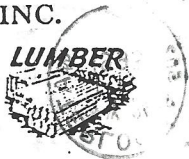
