PECAN BARS

1 Package Yellow Cake Mix

(take out 2/3 cup of mix for filling)

1/2 cup melted oleo

1 egg

Mix until crumbly Press into a greased 9/13 cake pan and bake at 350° for 15-20 minutes FILLING -

2/3 cup cake mix

1/2 cup brown sugar

1 1/2 cups dark corn syrup

1 teaspoon vanilla

3 eggs

Beat on Medium speed for 1-2 minutes.

Pour over baked crust. Sprinkle with pecans and return to oven for 30-35 minutes. Cool




