- Next fall, the City will need to trim several trees and bushes to assist in the snow removal process.



8.) Committee Reports







Chocolate syrup




The Fertile Garden Club held their Annual Christmas Party at the home of Mary Ann Wellik on December 11th at 6:30 p.m.. All members were present
