Other Updates:

- Friends of the EPL Community Room Fundraiser & Renovation Project
 - As of March 1st, the fundraiser has brought in an expected \$202,466 out of the original \$222,000 goal. The Friends Board has voted to approve two change orders (so far) that will extend the total project cost to \$253,363.
