Dear Friends Board Members.

Attached please find a proof of the donor wall image laid over the space to give you an idea of proportion against the wall. I've also taken a photo of the physical sample Amy's Sign Design provided of a 3-dimensional leaf in a cherry finish. Both the trunk and multi-sized leaves will be made of thinly-sliced wood. The price will run \$2,500-\$3,800.

Shown on the image are donors at the \$100 level and above. Lili and I had originally looked at a sample with \$500 and above, and decided the tree looked better with more leaves, and setting it at \$100 allows us to recognize more donors. Note that we can add leaves at any time.

The lighter tone didn't stand out enough against our paint color, but the one I sent along all three of us agreed looked very nice against it. I regret that the poor lighting in the community

room right now didn't allow us to get an image of the paint color with the wood slice in front in a way that shows its true appearance.

The trunk will be several shades darker than the leaves, as depicted in the proof, and will also be made of wood. I do have the wood sample piece and a 12x12" sample of our paint color that I could show you if you wanted to stop by and look at it.
