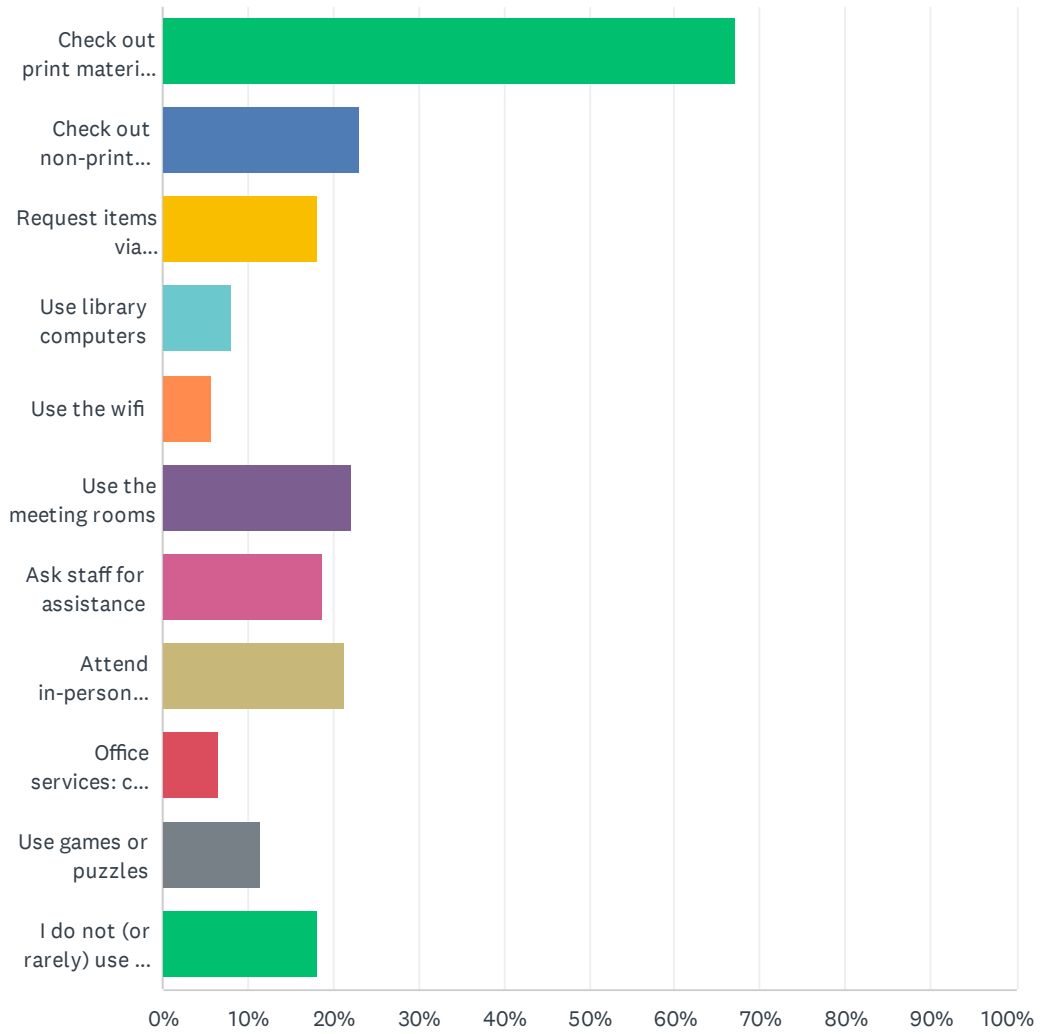

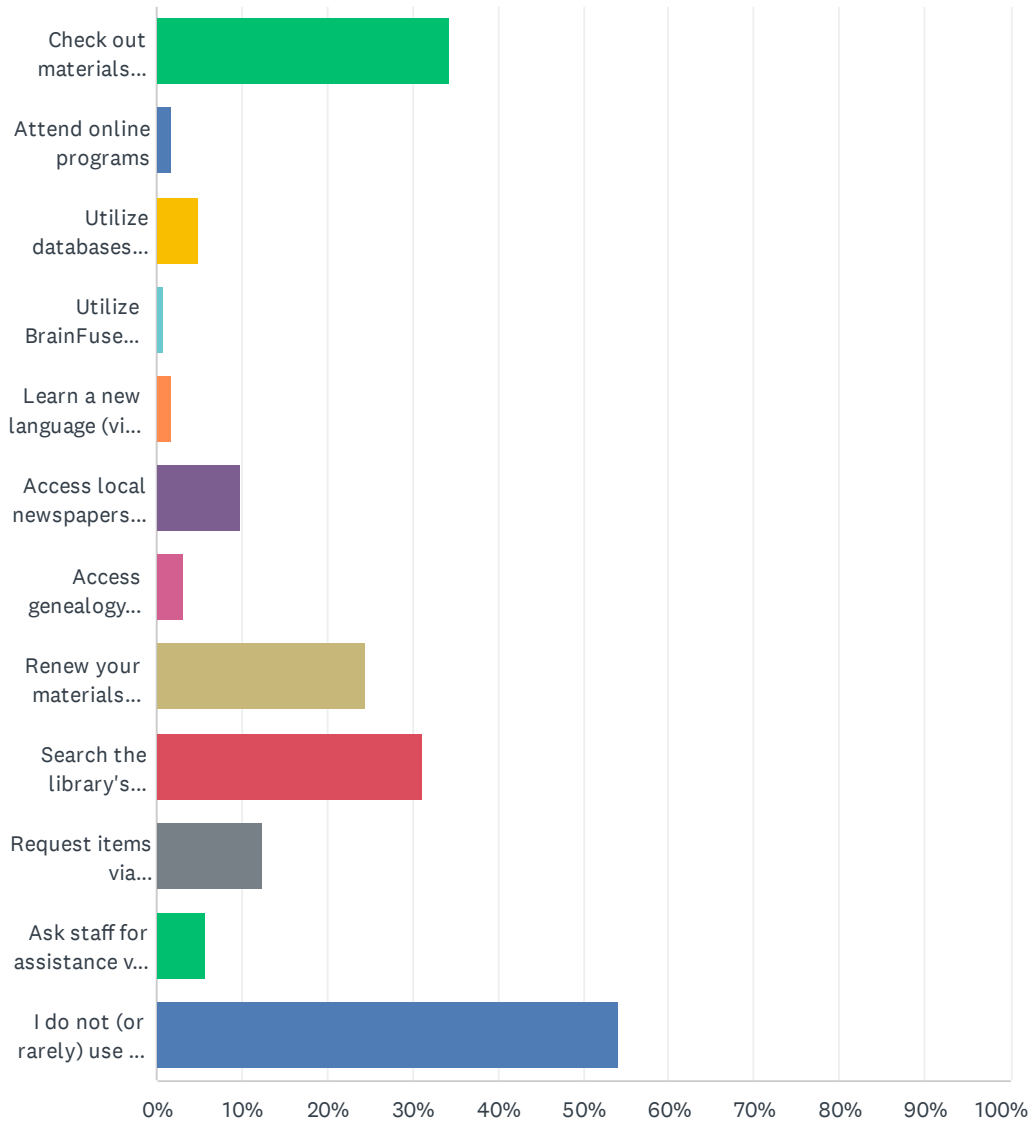

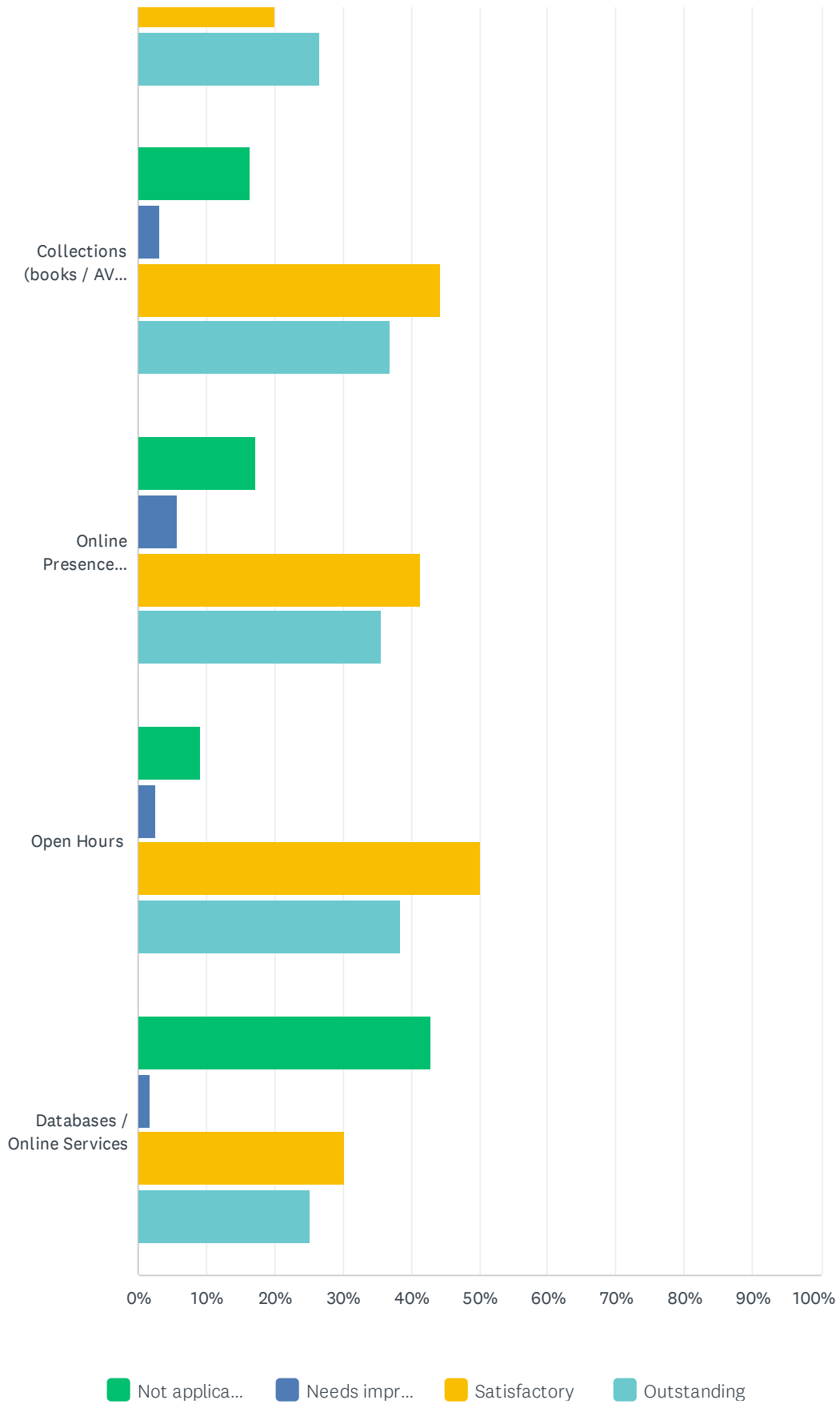

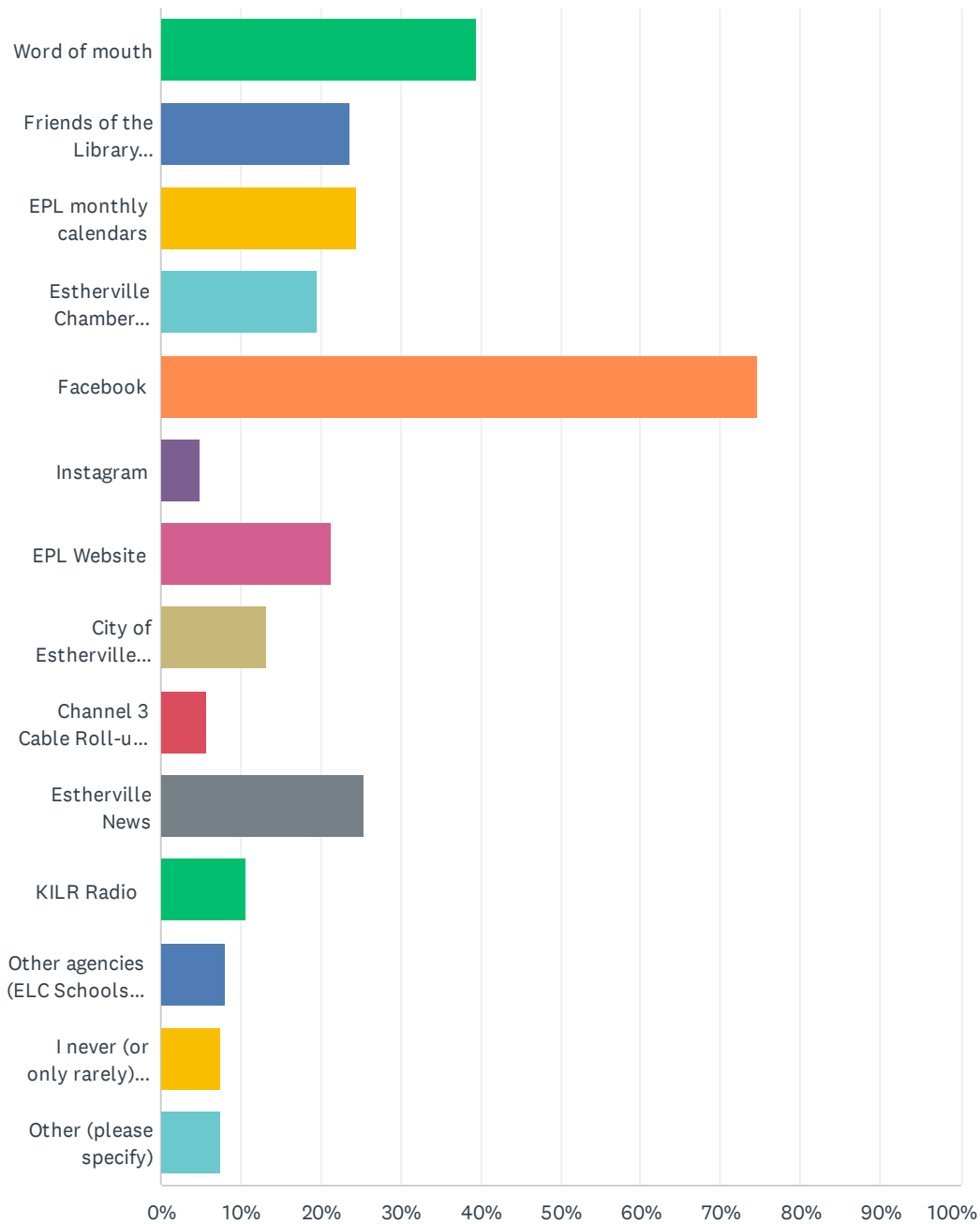

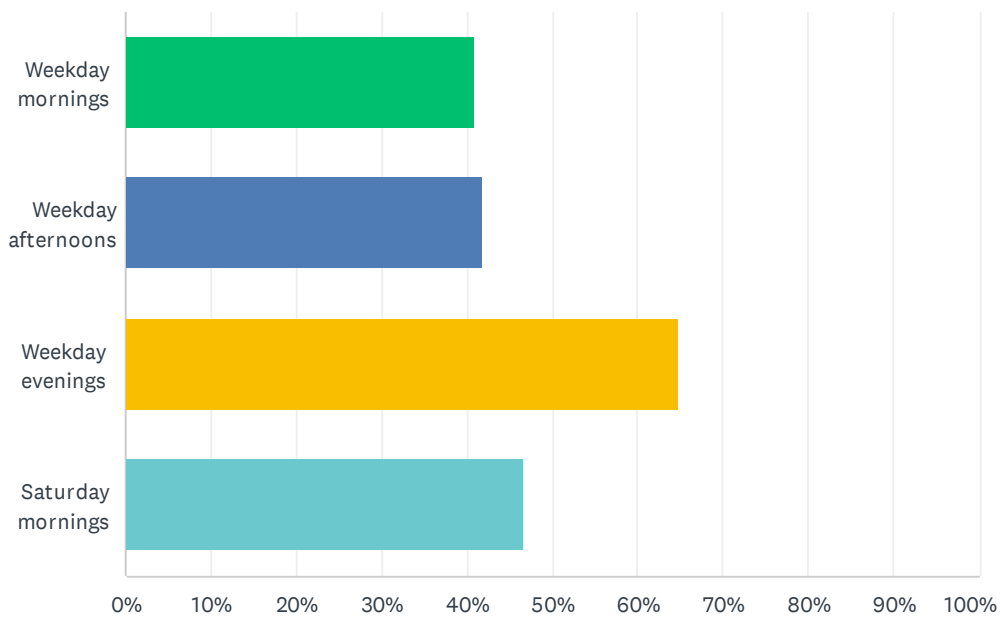

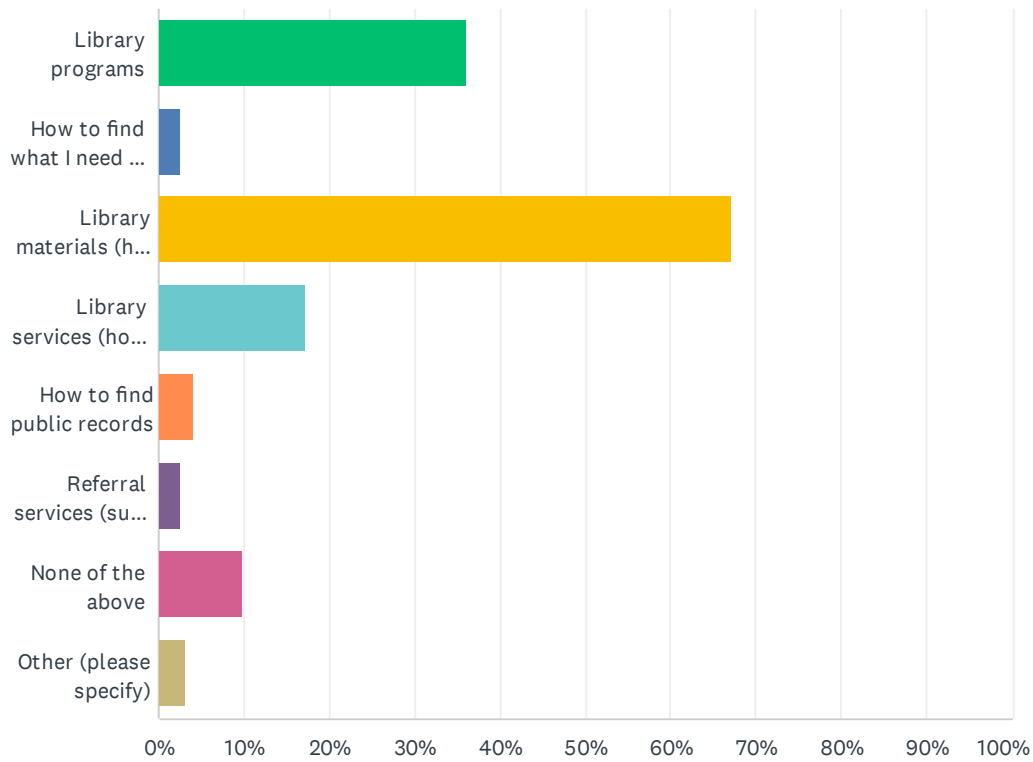

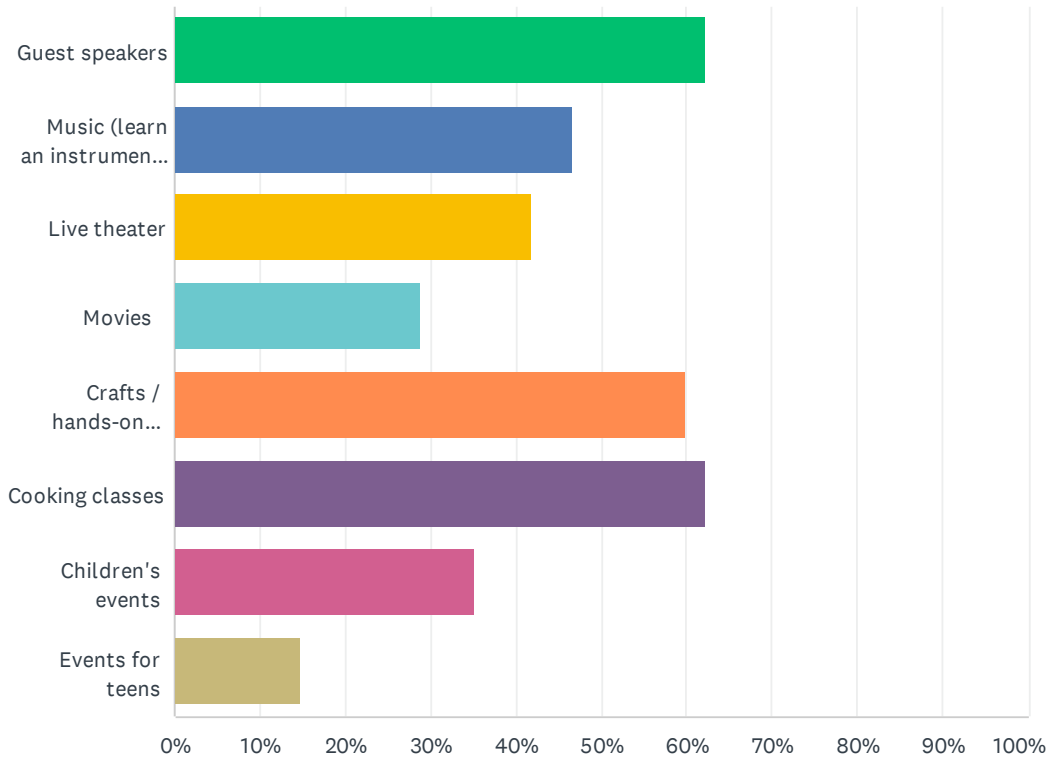

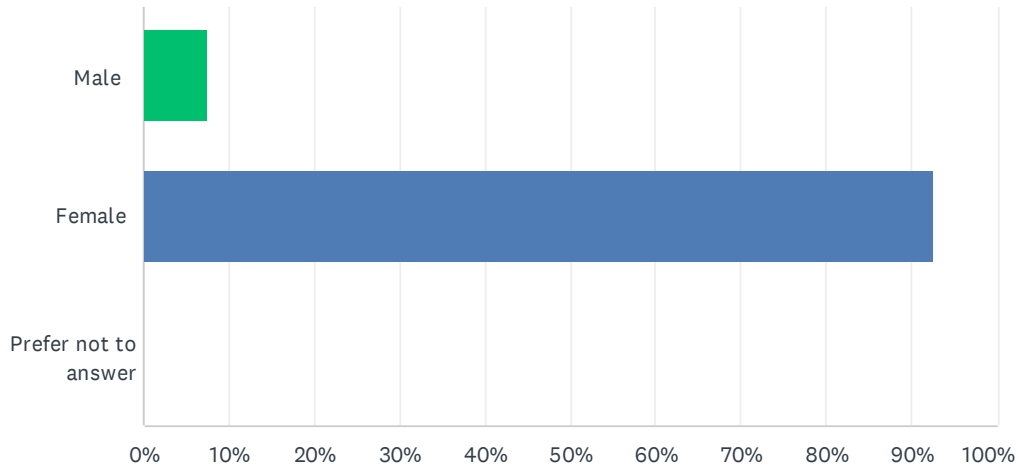

# Q11 Gender

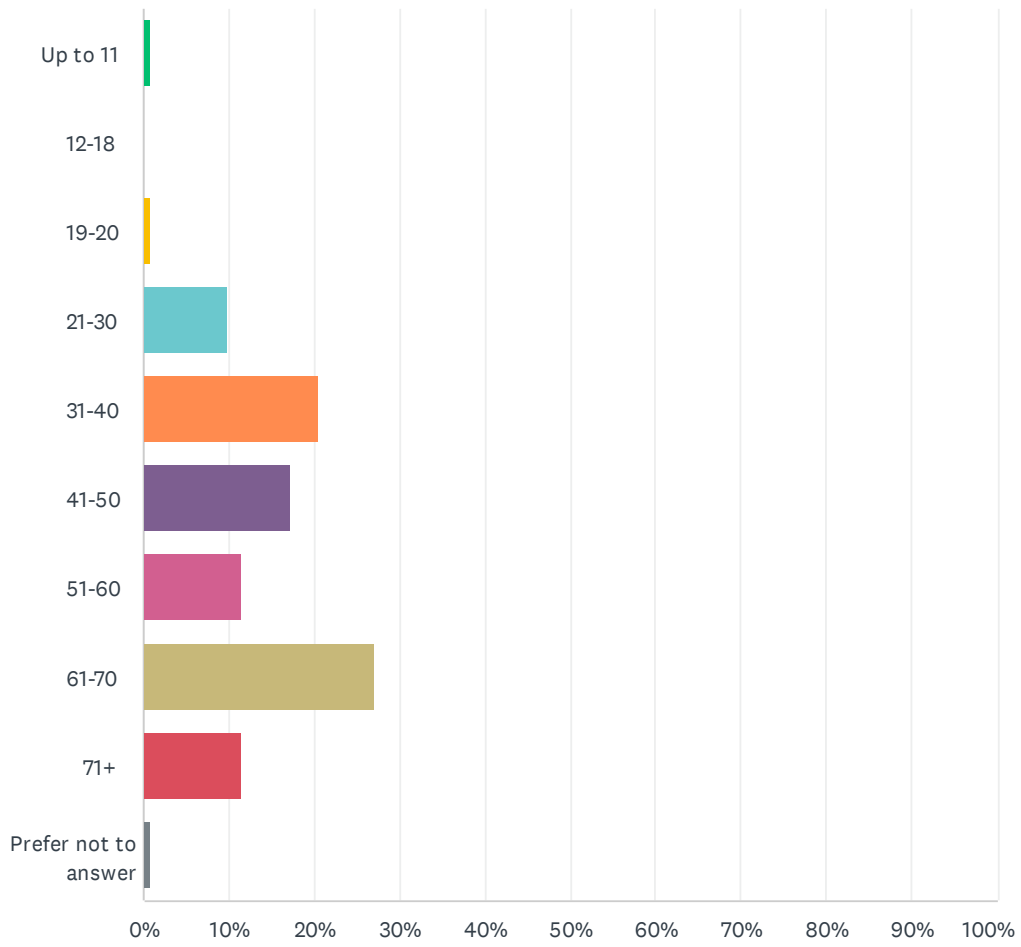

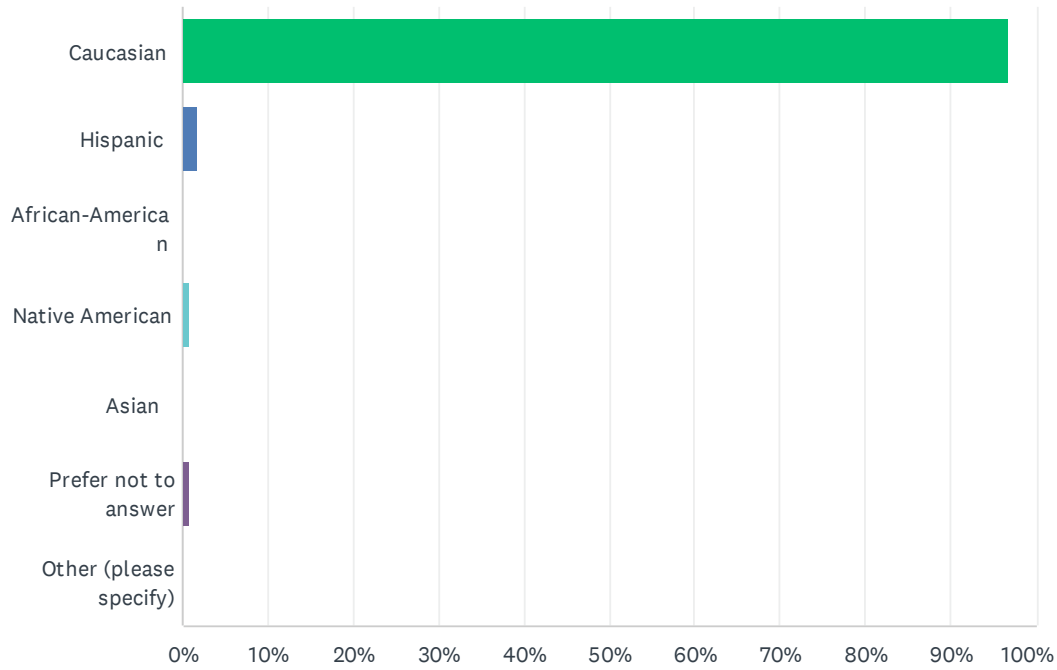

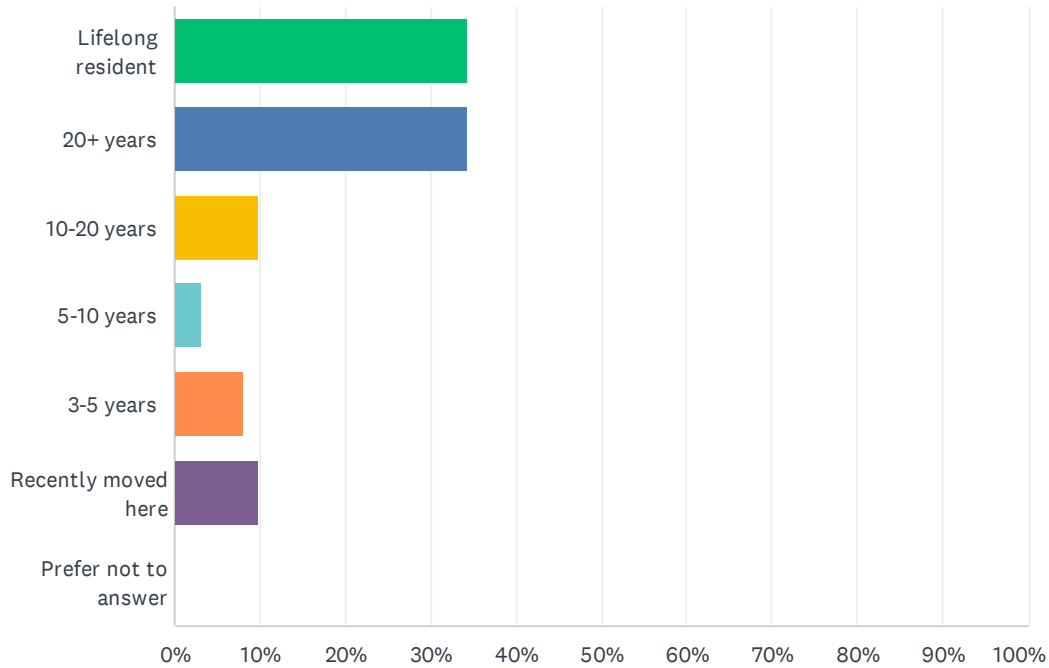

### Q14 How long have you been a part of the community (living/working/passing through the area)?

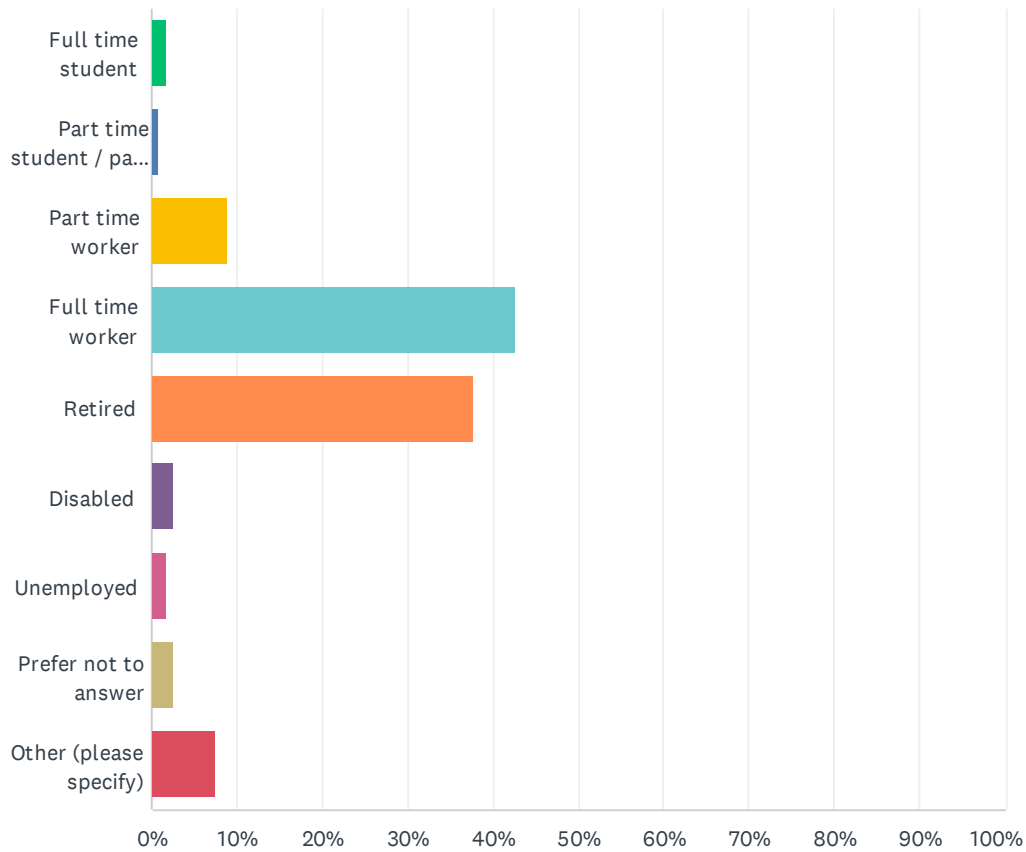

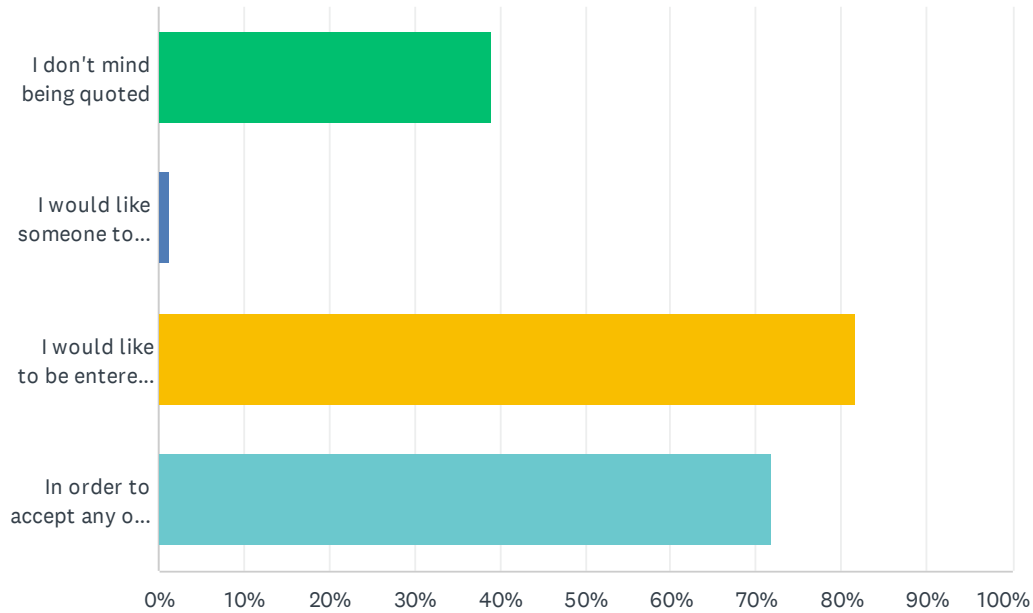
