There should be enough money to pay the presenters with the donations we have received. Sarah D. presented several operetta and play books as well as some literary books from the Heritage Center that were duplicates, in very poor condition or had no discernable connection to Beaman or the Beaman school. She requested removal from the collections. The removal was approved. They will be sold or recycled.
